

Kati Becher discovered her passion for painting through experimentation, trying out various techniques and exploring different themes, such as nature painting, animal portraits, and graphic painting with a sense of archaic forms. Following an inner logic, she approaches her inner motifs—animals, expansive landscapes, and abstract fantasies—with brush, palette knife, and paint.

Regular trips to the Mediterranean region, which greatly influenced her painting, gradually led to the development of her characteristic visual language, often realized through interesting color combinations.

A love of detail, combined with the expansiveness of diverse abstractions, is typical of her work. Thematically, a wide range is evident. The painter comes across as authentic due to her solid approach and grounded perspective on life. She succeeds in realizing her artistic ambitions and consistently working on her ideas.

In 2024, her dream came true, and she emigrated to Veli Lošinj in Croatia. There, at Easter 2025, she opened her own gallery "Galerija katapehar", which has since become a meeting place for art lovers.

- Since 2008, study trips have increasingly taken me to the Mediterranean region, including Croatia, Portugal, and Tuscany, as well as the British Isles – creating small works on location.
- From 2010 onwards, I have received inspiration from various art seminars.
- In 2015, my focus shifted to serial projects – e.g., underwater, mountain, and birdlife cycles, as well as animal portraits.
- Artistic projects in the areas of wave-gothic art, abstract forest painting, and portraits of music bands.
- Since 2018, I have been a member of the Eurovision Artists' Association, and in 2019, its art book "Landscapes of First Love" was published.
